

Goal: To be independent and mobile so I can get out into my community to go to school/work and participate in my social activities.

Working towards achieving this goal you could receive assistance for social and community participation may include cost to attend camps etc. minor or major car modifications, powered wheelchairs or mobility scooters, clothing modifications for school uniforms and everyday items that need to be altered. NDIS would fund alterations to the clothes, as buying clothes is an everyday expense for all. But if due to you or your child's stature an off the rack item or uniform is not suitable, and therefore needs to be made, NDIS could fund the difference between buying a uniform off the rack to having one made. Bear in mind that some modifications/alterations are simple and don't require the cost of a tailor etc. This goal would also include physio/therapies to ensure mobility.

Goal: To be safe and independent in my home

This goal would include OT assessments, minor or major home modifications, assistance with household chores, and responsibilities. Assistive technology and aids recommended by OT.
